- 1) How many providers are to be trained?  
There are approximately 5,400 license exempt providers and 2,200 licensed in-home providers.
- 2) Who currently has the contract?  
WAEYC – Washington Association for the Education of Young Children
- 3) Who is applying for the contract?  
We are not at liberty to disclose that information.
- 4) Will training be required to be online?  
We are asking for training in numerous different formats, including online.
- 5) Is the training currently offered online?  
Yes. Online training became available in May 2009.
- 6) Where can I find information about subsidy billing procedures?

- 7) Is the training to be provided statewide?  
Yes.
- 8) Since the training is statewide may I partner with other organizations?  
Yes, we encourage creative proposals. However, we require the contact of one individual and prefer to contract with one organization. All details and the responsibilities of each partner must be clearly outlined in the proposal.
- 9) Is there currently a curriculum developed?  
Yes. Please refer to question 5. However, we are looking for new ideas and approaches. In addition, there have been some changes due to recent legislation that must be updated. The current curriculum will, therefore, need to be modified.
- 10) Will the contractor be able to receive input from DEL and providers?  
Yes. The RFP states that DEL will provide input and feedback. DEL currently does not have a provider input group.
- 11) Are men allowed to apply?  
Yes. We are an equal opportunity employer.
- 12) How long should the training last?  
The training is currently 3 hours long for in-person training.
- 13) How would you like to receive the letter of intent?
