Eligibility for the Seasonal Child Care Program

The purpose of the Seasonal Child Care Program is to help ensure safe, healthy places for children while their parents work in seasonal agriculture.

You may be eligible for this program if both parents work in the fields, orchards or packing sheds,

AND IF YOU:

- Work less than 11 months per year for the same employer
- Receive no TANF money
- Have children 12 years old or younger (if "special need care" is required, 18 or younger)
- Meet income requirements

PLEASE NOTE:

The Seasonal Child Care Program has limited funds. Participation is not guaranteed for all who apply.

You need to bring this information with you to apply for the program:

- Receipts of all family income for the past 12 months
Any combination of these records is acceptable: W-2's, pay stubs, letter from employer showing earnings, welfare stubs, unemployment benefit receipts or printouts
- Welfare termination letter
- Identification of all children in the household
Any document showing birthdate is acceptable, such as: birth certificate, immunization record, school record, medical coupons
- Name, address and phone number of employer in Washington State
- Days and hours of employment
- Home address in Washington State
