

Homeless Child Care Program

The Homeless Child Care program offers short-term, free child care for eligible families who are experiencing homelessness. The family must be involved in qualifying activities and not eligible for another child care subsidy program. Subsidies are provided so that children can attend licensed child care while adults in the family participate in activities to stabilize the family.

Qualifying activities include:

- Accessing other social services
- Seeking permanent housing
- Seeking employment or involved in employment activity
- Attending appointments for:
 - Medical or mental health
 - Substance abuse
 - Violence avoidance
 - Legal

Families may be eligible if they:

- Do not have a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence
- Live in a shelter, car or park
- Live in transitional housing
- Live temporarily with family or friends
